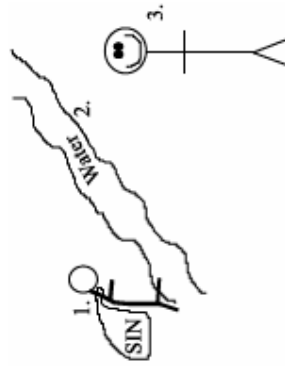
Praying for the Sick

Guidelines -- Luke 10:1-20

Guidelines -- Luke 10:1-20

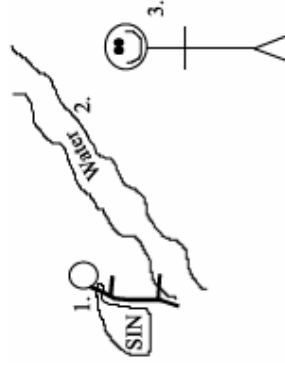

Making a House Church

Guidelines -- Luke 10:1-20

A simple definition of church is "Where two or more are gathered in the name of Jesus to obey all his commands in love." After baptism, make a church by doing this: 1. Appoint a leader. Typically, every home will have a natural leader. This is usually the father. 2. Ask the leader if he will do his best to help his church love and obey Jesus. 3. Ask all the members of the church if they will do their best to love and obey Jesus. 4. Say a simple prayer like this: "Jesus please help this church to love and obey you, Amen"
