- 1 Announced by heaven & by John (1-3)
- 2 Early teaching and miracles (4-5)
- 3 Public fame and favor (6-9)
- 4 Early rejections (10-12)
- 5 Moving towards the cross (13-17)
- 6 Final days at Jerusalem (18-19)
- 7 Crucifixion and resurrection (20-21)

Saturday, March 28, 33, Nisan 8, #116

• Passover: Friday, April 14, 33, Nisan 14

Sunday, March 29, AD 33 Nisan 9, #117

- Colt: Mature, had carried other loads.
- Hosanna: هوشا لا = הוֹשׁיעה נַא = "Please, Save!"
- Visitation: Roman invasion of AD 65-72. (Only 7-year 'tribulation' in the NT.)

Monday, March 30, 33, Nisan 10, #118

- Leaves: That variety yields spring fruit as well as larger autumn fruit.
- Temple: 1000s gathered there daily.

Tuesday, March 31, 33, Nisan 11, #119

- Faith: in God, opposite of doubt.
- Believing: that you are receiving.
- ["But if you do not..."]: Two fifth-century, uncial, Greek manuscripts.
- Forgive: Spite hinders prayer results.

Wednesday, April 1, 33, Nisan 12, #120

• Authority: Delegated right to command.
