Acts 2 ⁴¹ So then, those who had received his word were baptized; and there were **added** that day about three thousand souls.

οἱ μὲν οὖν ἀποδεξάμενοι τὸν λόγον αὐτοῦ ἐβαπτίσθησαν καὶ προσετέθησαν ἐν τῇ ἡμέρᾳ ἐκείνῃ ψυχαὶ ὡσεὶ τρισχίλια.

Acts 2 ⁴⁷ praising God, and having favor with all the people. And the Lord was **adding** to their number day by day those who were being saved.

αἰνοῦντες τὸν θεὸν καὶ ἔχοντες χάριν πρὸς ὅλον τὸν λαόν. ὁ δὲ κύριος προσετίθει τοὺς σωζομένους καθ' ἡμέραν ἐπὶ τὸ αὐτό.

Acts 5 ¹⁴ And all the more believers in the Lord, multitudes of men and women, were constantly **added** to their number;

μᾶλλον δὲ προσετίθεντο πιστεύοντες τῷ κυρίῳ, πλήθη ἀνδρῶν τε καὶ γυναικῶν

Acts 6 ¹ Now at this time while the disciples [**multiplying**], a complaint arose on the part of the Hellenistic *Jews* against the *native* Hebrews

Ἐν δὲ ταῖς ἡμέραις ταύταις πληθυνόντων τῶν μαθητῶν ἐγένετο γογγυσμὸς τῶν Ἑλληνιστῶν πρὸς τοὺς Ἑβραίους

Acts 6 ⁷ And the word of God kept on [**increasing**]; and the number of the disciples continued to [**multiply**] in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests were becoming obedient to the faith.

Καὶ ὁ λόγος τοῦ θεοῦ ἤϋξανεν καὶ ἐπληθύνετο ὁ ἀριθμὸς τῶν μαθητῶν ἐν Ἱερουσαλὴμ σφόδρα, πολὺς τε ὄχλος τῶν ἱερέων ὑπήκουον τῇ πίστει.

Acts 7 ¹⁷ “But as the time of the promise was approaching which God had assured to Abraham, the people **increased** and **multiplied** in Egypt,

Καθὼς δὲ ἤγγιζεν ὁ χρόνος τῆς ἐπαγγελίας ἧς ὠμολόγησεν ὁ θεὸς τῷ Ἀβραάμ, ἠϋξήσεν ὁ λαὸς καὶ ἐπληθύνθη ἐν Αἰγύπτῳ

Acts 9 ³¹ So the church throughout all Judea and Galilee and Samaria enjoyed peace, being built up; and, going on in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, it continued to [**multiply**].

Ἡ μὲν οὖν ἐκκλησία καθ' ὅλης τῆς Ἰουδαίας καὶ Γαλιλαίας καὶ Σαμαρείας εἶχεν εἰρήνην οἰκοδομουμένη καὶ πορευομένη τῷ φόβῳ τοῦ κυρίου καὶ τῇ παρακλήσει τοῦ ἁγίου πνεύματος ἐπληθύνετο.

Acts 11 ²⁴ for he was a good man, and full of the Holy Spirit and of faith. And considerable numbers were [**added**] to the Lord.

ὅτι ἦν ἀνὴρ ἀγαθὸς καὶ πλήρης πνεύματος ἁγίου καὶ πίστεως. καὶ προσετέθη ὄχλος ἰκανὸς τῷ κυρίῳ.

Acts 12 ²⁴ But the word of the Lord continued to [**increase**] and to be **multiplied**.²⁵ And Barnabas and Saul returned from Jerusalem when they had fulfilled their mission, taking along with *them* John, who was also called Mark. Ὁ δὲ λόγος τοῦ θεοῦ ἠϋξανεν καὶ ἐπληθύνετο.

2 Cor 9 ¹⁰ Now He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food, will supply and **multiply** your seed for sowing and **increase** the harvest of your righteousness;

¹⁰ ὁ δὲ ἐπιχορηγῶν σπῶρον τῷ σπείροντι καὶ ἄρτον εἰς βρῶσιν χορηγήσει καὶ πληθυνεῖ τὸν σπῶρον ὑμῶν καὶ αὐξήσει τὰ γενήματα τῆς δικαιοσύνης ὑμῶν.

Heb 6 ¹⁴ saying, “I will surely bless you, and I will surely **multiply** you.”

Acts 19 ²⁰ So the word of the Lord was [**increasing**] mightily and prevailing.
