General Plan for Sustainable Reproduction

1. Envision

- a. Envision a hundred new churches in three years
 - i. Joyful believers
 - ii. Obedient disciples
 - iii. Healty churches
 - iv. Compenent leaders
 - v. Visionary trainers
- b. Envision four generations of churches and church leaders
- c. Choose surrounding localities and hold prayer walks round them
- d. Raise up or send in teams of two or three volunteers

2. Share the Good News

- a. Instruct team members
- b. Authorize and send them
- c. Enter the homes of "persons of peace" (men or woman)

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- d. Meet every kind of spiritual need
- e. Share the Good News several times
 - i. T&M booklet N° 2 The Best News
 - ii. T&M booklet N° 2-1 The spiritual danger we face

 - iv. T&M booklet N° 2-3 All have sinned and must repent
 - v. T&M booklet N° 2-4 Buried with Christ in baptism
 - vi. T&M booklet N° 2-5 The risen Lord Jesus saves us by faith
 - vii. T&M booklet N° 2-6 The bread that gives eternal life

3. Make disciples

- a. Teach them to obey together Jesus' commandments (Mt 28:18-20)
- b. Show them how to put into practice seven basic commandments of Jesus (Acts 2:36-47))
 - i. T&M booklet No 7 We follow Jesus Christ
 - ii. T&M booklet No 7-1 Jesus Christ comforts the fearful
 - iii. T&M booklet No 7-2 The gift of the Holy Spirit
 - iv. T&M booklet No 7-3 Love your neighbor and your ennemy
 - v. T&M booklet No 7-4 Participate in the Lord's Supper
 - vi. T&M booklet No 7-5 Pray and meditate on God's Word every day
 - vii. T&M booklet No 7-6 Give with joy
 - viii. T&M booklet No 7-7 Make disciples for the Lord Jesus Christ

4. Strengthen the disciples

- a. Teach them how to face persecution
- b. Teach them to employ their authority in Christ

5. Recognize new churches

- a. Church = Jesus in the midst of those who obey his commandments (Mt 16; 18; 28)
- b. More than a gathering of learners who passively listen to messages

6. Appoint « elders »

- a. Name and authorize shepherds in every church, however young it may be.
- b. Entrust them to the Lord and charge them to practice all of Jesus commandments.
- c. Elder qualifications (see the chart in the appendix)

7. Train all elders

- a. Enroll church shepherds in a T&M extension course
 - i. T&M booklet No 24 Pastoral training and you
 - ii. F-M Student activity guide
- b. Extend training chains to their fourth generation and beyond (2 Tim. 2:2)
 - i. Paul (you serve as a model and a trainer)
 - ii. Timothy (those accountable to you)
 - iii. Faithful persons (who follow your instructions)
 - iv. Others also (qui font de même ailleurs)
- c. Hold training workshops like this one
- d. Keep stocks of T&M training booklets available to all who train others.

8. Multiply churches

- a. Visualise all churches continually reproducing
- b. Openly authorize every church to start little, new churches
- c. Continually train volunteer workers at every level
- d. Show every new church how to enjoy a body life like that described in 1 Cor 14.24 à 26
- e. Remove all non-biblical hindrances
- f. Train most new workers in the way Jesus and the apostles did, by mentoring them
- g. Employ only methods and materials that most folk can afford and immitate
- h. Follow their progress, analyze statistics, learn lessons and keep on growing
- i. Cultivate financial integrity and practice careful book-keeping

9. Expand the Kingdom of God

- a. Acts 1:8. Villages, regions, countries, beyond
- b. Other countries have chosen to make Senegal an international commercial hub
- c. Aim to launch mouvements that will mobilize and support thousands of workers
