

### Early Variant Readings in Hebrews 1:1–2:4

mss = manuscript(s)

- 1:1 One third-century mss and several later translations read “our fathers”.  
One fourth-century Greek mss, and some later mss, have a plural form of the adjective “last”.
- 1:2 One circa year 200 Greek mss, and some later mss, omit the adverb “also” before the verb “created”.
- 1:3 One fourth-century Greek mss reads “manifests” (*phanerôn*) in place of “upholds” (*phérôn*).  
One circa year 200 Greek mss, and some later mss, omit the possessive “his” from before the noun “power”.  
One fourth-century Greek mss, and some later mss, inserts the possessive “our” before the noun “sins”.
- 1:4 One circa year 200 Greek mss, and one fourth-century Greek mss, omit “the” before “angels”.
- 1:8 One fourth-century Greek mss, and some later mss, omit “and ever” from after “forever”.
- 1:12 One fourth-century Greek mss, and some later mss, replace “roll up” with “change”.
- 2:4 One fourth-century Greek mss has a shorter form (*summarturounto*) of “testifying with” (*sunepimarturontos*).
