

## Hebrews 3:3 – 4:1

### Textual Variants

- 3:4 A few manuscripts insert a definite article before “all things”.
- 3:6 Instead of “even if”, some manuscripts read “if” or “and should”.  
A few ancient manuscripts insert “steadfast unto (the) end” after “hold fast”.
- 3:9 Most ancient manuscripts do not have the pronoun “me” before “test”.
- 3:10 Different manuscripts read, “this” or “that” before “generation”.  
One ancient manuscript reads “wherefore” instead of “and”.
- 3:13 A few ancient manuscripts have “exhort” in the aorist tense rather than in the present tense.
- 3:17 One very ancient manuscript reads, “disobeyed” in place of “sinned”.
- 3:18 Another very ancient manuscript reads “disbelieved” in place of “disobeyed”.
