TENTATIVE ANALYSIS OF THE LOGIC OF HEBREWS 4:1-13

Rest = resting place = God's 'home' = world to come

Three exhortations

- 1. 2:1 THEREFORE We must pay attention lest we drift away from God's promise.
- **2. 3:1 THEREFORE** Consider Jesus our Apostle and High-priest, superior to Moses.
- **3. 4:1 THEREFORE** Let us fear lest any fall short whist God's promise stands.

Three explanations

- (A) **FOR** We have been evangelized, but hearing without faith is worthless.
- (B) **FOR** It remains believers who are entering God's 'home'.

<u>Proof</u>: Ps. 95:11 = God's 'home' is ready. The faithless are excluded.

(C) 4 FOR scripture says God's 'home' is ready. Gen. 2:2 with Ps. 95:11.

Two inferences

(A) ⁶ **THEREFORE** some will enter God's 'home'.

<u>Proof</u>: Ps. 95:7 = Today ! (six hundred years after the Exodus).

Explanation

⁸ FOR Joshua did not bring them to God's 'home'.

Inference

⁹ **THUS** God's people will enter his 'home' without working for it.

Explanation

- ¹⁰ **FOR** those entering in rest from their works.
- (B) 11 THEREFORE Let us strive to enter God's 'home', not disobeying as Israel did.

Reason

- 12 FOR The Word of God examines our thoughts.
- ¹³ **AND** No one can hide from him.
