

Variant Manuscript Readings

Hebrews 8:1-13

Ancient manuscript = fifth century CE or earlier

- 8:2** A few ancient manuscripts insert 'and' before 'not man'.
- 8:6** A few ancient manuscripts read 'now' (*nun*) instead of 'as it is' (*nuni*).
- 8:7** One ancient manuscript reads 'another' (*heteras*) instead of 'second' (*deuteras*) before covenant.
- 8:8** A few ancient manuscripts read 'finding fault *with them*' (*autois*) instead of 'faulting *them*' (*autous*).
- 8:9** One ancient manuscript reads plural 'days' (*hémerais*) instead of singular 'day' (*hémerai*).
- 8:10** A few ancient manuscripts insert 'my' before 'covenant'.
- One ancient manuscript reads singular 'heart' (*kardias*) instead of plural 'hearts' (*kardian*).
- A few ancient manuscripts have the simple verb 'write' (*graphô*) instead of the compound verb 'write-upon' (*epigraphô*).
- 8:11** One ancient manuscript omits 'his' before 'brother'.
- 8:12** A few ancient manuscripts replace 'sins' with 'sins and transgressions', or with 'transgressions and sins', or with 'transgressions'.
