<u>Thesis</u>	
9:26	Messiah has appeared once for all to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.
	Explanation 1
10:1	For: "The law can never make perfect those who draw near."
	<u>Reason</u>
10:2	Since: They would have ceased, but they did not.
	<u>Explanation</u>
10:4	The blood of beasts cannot take away sins.
	<u>Inferences</u>
10:5	Wherefore: Messiah came to replace the first covenant with the second.
	This was foretold in Psalm 40:6-8.
10:10	"We have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all."
	Explanation 2
10:11	And: "The same sacrifices can never take away sins."
	<u>Contrast</u>
10:12	But: "Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins."
	<u>Explanation</u>
10:14	For: "by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are being sanctified."
10:15	And: The Holy Spirit testified to this in Jeremiah 31:33 and 34.
10:18	And: "There is no longer any offering for sin."
