- 1. Yahweh spoke by 2 Isaiah writer(s).
- 2. Guilds conserved their writings.
- 3. Thus, 2 Isaiah is inspired by God.
- 4. Jesus fulfilled 2 Isaiah prophecies.
- 5. Jesus affirmed 2 Isaiah prophecies.
- 6. Jesus' apostles applied 2 Isaiah in their writings.
- 7. Thus, NT writings are inspired by God.

What/Who is the 'restrainer'?

- Paul sought to understand when Jesus might return.
- Paul found some answers in 2 Isaiah 66, employing its language.
- There had to be a mission to Gentiles.
- The end-times cannot come before that mission succeeds.
- Opposition to his mission came from resistant Jews.
- Yahweh is restraining the appearing of the end-times Man of Sin.
- Until the Gentile mission be fulfilled.
- "that which" (neuter) restrains = the incomplete mission.
