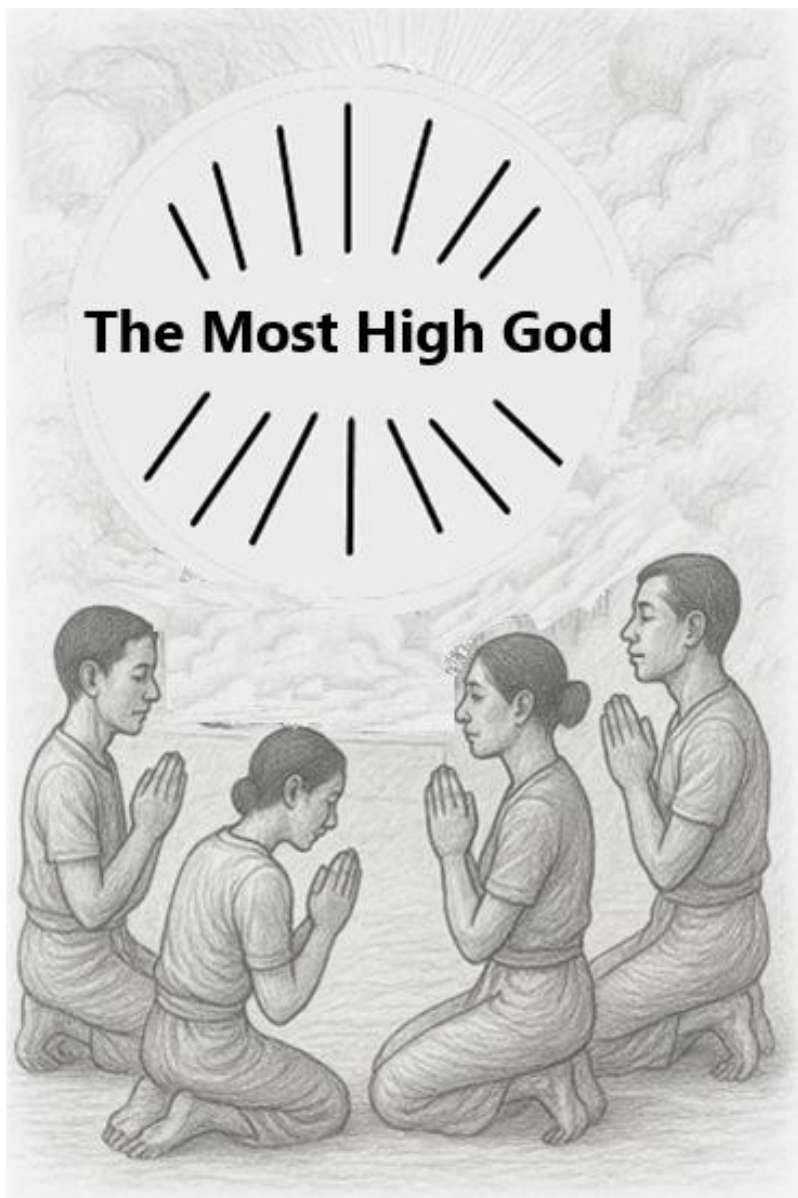




The Forgotten God
