Allusions to End-Times Passages in Ephesians 6:10-20

Ephesians 6.11, 13, 14 "Stand"

"You may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil... Able to withstand in the evil day... Stand therefore."

Compare Jesus' instructions: "Stay alert at all times, praying that you may have strength ... to stand before the Son of Man" (Luke 21:36).

Ephesians 5:8, 11; 6:12 "Darkness"

"This present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil."

Compare: "You are not in darkness, brothers, for that day to surprise you like a thief. For you are all children of light, children of the day. We are not of the night or of the darkness" (1 Thess. 5:4-5).

Ephesians 6:14, "Truth"

"Having fastened on the belt of truth."

Compare 2 Thessalonians 2:10, 12, 13, "They found no place in their hearts for the truth so as to be saved... Who have not believed the truth... Sanctification by the Spirit and faith in the truth".

Ephesians 6:17, "Helmet of salvation"

"Take the helmet of salvation."

Compare: "[The LORD] ... his desire to **deliver** is like a **helmet** on his head" (Isa. 59:17).

Ephesians 6:17, "Word of God"

"The sword of the Spirit (which is the word of God)."

Compare: "All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable (2 Tim. 3:16).

Ephesians 6:18 "Alert ... praying"

"With every prayer and petition, pray at all times in the Spirit, and to this end be alert."

Compare: "Stay alert at all times, praying that you may have strength to escape all these things that must happen, and to stand before the Son of Man" (Luke 21:36).

Ephesians 6:18, "Time = kairos, season"

"Praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication."

Compare: "You know what holds him back, so that he will be revealed in his own time" (2 Thess. 2:6).

Compare: "Concerning the times and the seasons, brothers, you have no need to have anything written to you"(1 Thess. 5:1)

Compare: "In the last days difficult times will come" (2 Timothy 3:1).

Compare: "The devil has come down to you in great wrath, because he knows that his time is short!" (Rev. 12:12).

Compare: "The woman ... is to be nourished for a time, and times, and half a time" (Rev. 12:14).

Ephesians 6:19, "Gospel"

"Put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace."

Compare "This gospel of the kingdom will be preached throughout the whole inhabited earth as a testimony to all the nations, and then the end will come.

Compare: "To this he called you through our <mark>gospel</mark>, so that you may obtain the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ" (2 Thess. 2:14).
