

To foreknow. προ·γνώσκω pro·gnōskō

Acts 26:5 - They have known for a long time. πάντες [οἱ] Ἰουδαῖοι προγνώσκοντές με ἀνωθεν. Jewish leaders knew Paul from the start, before current events.

Rom. 8:29 - Those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son.

Before being conformed to the image of his Son.

Rom. 11:2 - God has not rejected his people whom he foreknew. οὐκ ἀπώσατο ὁ θεὸς τὸν λαὸν αὐτοῦ ὃν προέγνω.

Israel whom God has known for a long while.

1 Pet. 1:20 He was destined before the foundation of the world but was revealed at the end of the ages for your sake. προεγνωσμένου μὲν πρὸ καταβολῆς κόσμου φανερωθέντος δὲ ἐπ' ἐσχάτου τῶν χρόνων δι' ὑμᾶς

God foreknow Christ before the foundation of the world (First world? Or world to come?) John 17

Jn 15:24 Father, I desire that they also, whom you have given me, may be with me where I am, to see my glory that you have given me because **you loved me** before the foundation of the world.

2 Pet. 3:17 - you are forewarned, beware that you are not carried away with the error of the lawless. To know a danger before being caught.

Foreknowledge. πρό·γνωσις pro·gnōsis

Acts 2:23 according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified

1 Pet. 1:2 – who have been chosen and destined by God the Father and sanctified by the Spirit to be obedient to Jesus Christ and to be sprinkled with his blood.

When your became obedient to Jesus Christ.

ἐκλεκτοῖς ... **κατὰ** πρόγνωσιν θεοῦ πατρὸς **ἐν** ἀγιασμῷ πνεύματος **εἰς** ὑπακοὴν καὶ ῥαντισμὸν αἵματος Ἰησοῦ Χριστοῦ, χάρις ὑμῖν καὶ εἰρήνη πληθυνθείη.

To pre-destine. προ·ορίζω proorizō

Acts 4:28 - to do whatever your hand and your plan had predestined to take place.

Rom. 8:29 - those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son.

Rom. 8:30 - And those whom he predestined he also called.

1 Cor. 2:7 - a hidden mystery, which God decreed before the ages for our glory. λαλοῦμεν θεοῦ σοφίαν ἐν μυστηρίῳ τὴν ἀποκεκρυμμένην, ἣν προώρισεν ὁ θεὸς πρὸ τῶν αἰώνων εἰς δόξαν ἡμῶν God destined before which ages? Past ages? Coming ages?

Eph. 1:5 - He destined us for adoption as his children through Jesus Christ, according to the good pleasure of his will.

Eph. 1:11 – destined according to the purpose of him who accomplishes all things according to his counsel and will.
